6. Authorize execution of First Amendment to the Subgrant Agreement between SD Dept. of Agriculture and Natural Resources and Town of Oacoma to extend the deadline date for completion of a wastewater facility study to December 31, 2023.
7. Consider haul road and project site agreement with Ringneck & Western Railroad, LLC on portions of Dougan Avenue, East 3rd Street, Morrow Avenue and the town's East Yard for hauling and storage of rock and railroad ties.
8. Consider proposal from Midco Diving & Marine Services to inspect the water storage standpipe at the water treatment plant, remove up to 3 inches of any sediment and issue a full report at a quoted cost of \$3,218. Any sediment removal exceeding 3 inches will be an additional charge.
9. Consider billboard proposal submitted by GF Advertising Services for the period of October 2022 to September 2024.
 - a. 12 ft x 48 ft non-illuminated, righthand reader near the Bridgewater Exit at MM 359. The vinyl from the existing illuminated sign at the Mitchell exit can be moved to the Bridgewater location.
 - b. 14 ft x 48 ft illuminated, lefthand reader near the Dakotafest site, Mitchell, at MM 333. A new vinyl to be made for the Dakotafest location at a cost of \$1,400.
 - c. The total cost per year for the two new signs is \$15,730 or about \$1,311 per month, plus a one-time expense of \$1,400 for new vinyl at the Dakotafest location.
 - d. Two 4-week flights of free digital advertising in Sioux Falls on various 14 ft x 48 ft boards.
