

REGULAR MEETING OF THE OACOMA TOWN BOARD
July 5, 2023

The Oacoma Town Board met in regular session at 7:00 P.M. on July 5, 2023, in Meeting Room #2 at the Oacoma Community Center. Board members present were Gary Dominiack, President; Richard Kirkpatrick, Vice President; Kyle Fuchs; and Justin Rabern. Robin Hutmacher was absent. Also present were Valerie Moore, Finance Officer; Catland Landegent, Chamberlain Police Dept.; April LeBeau, Missouri Valley Crisis Center; and Jane Freeman.

MINUTES

Motion by Kirkpatrick, second by Fuchs, to approve the minutes of the regular meeting on June 19, 2023. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Time was reserved for public comments pursuant to SDCL 1-25-1. Jane Freeman asked for an update about the nuisance violations at 100 N Main Ave. Dominiack reported family members of the deceased deedholder visited the property and performed some maintenance. Freeman inquired about the ownership status of the property. Dominiack reported the parties' actions to clear the land title is a private matter which does not involve the city. Freeman inquired about the sewer main televising project and asked if results of the project are available. She was informed a report is not yet available and it must be submitted to the city's engineer before payment to the contractor can be made.

POLICE REPORT

Police Sergeant Landegent provided the 2023 second quarter police report for Oacoma and noted response to 43 calls. Officers issued 18 citations with 32 violations and 17 warnings.

2024 FUNDING REQUEST

April LeBeau, Executive Director of the Missouri Valley Crisis Center, provided information in support of her \$5,000 funding request from Oacoma for 2024. In addition to other statistics, LeBeau reported the crisis center provided 1,680 services to 301 individuals during the period of Jan 2022 to Dec 2022.

INVESTMENTS

The board reviewed an Investment Policy for the Town of Oacoma. Motion by Rabern, second by Fuchs, to adopt the Investment Policy for the Town of Oacoma as presented. Motion carried.

Motion by Rabern, second by Fuchs, to authorize Moore to establish a First Choice Business Money Market account and Certificate(s) of Deposit at First Dakota Bank with Moore, Dominiack and Kirkpatrick designated as authorized signors. Motion carried.
